Step 1: Preparing of salty dough

Estimated time: 15 min

Use the following ingredients to prepare the salty dough:

- 1 cup of flour
- ½ cup of salt
- 1 tablespoon of oil
- ½ cup of water

Each child kneads the ingredients in a large bowl until a soft dough forms.



Step 2: Modelling salt dough figures

Estimated time: 30 min

From the resulting dough, shape, model or cast models of Thracian treasure. The moulds should not be very thick so that moisture does not remain in them, and they remain soft. Bake (can also be microwaved for 2-3 min) or dry in the sun but takes longer (1 hr).



Step 3: Ready-made products

Estimated time: 15 min



Once the models are completely dry, colour them with tempera paints.

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
