### STEP BY STEP: How to recreate cave paintings.

#### Step 1: Palm print

Estimated time: 10 min

• Take a white sheet, coloured paints and a sponge.



• Outline drawing: place your palm on the sheet and trace the outline of your hand using the sponge soaked in paint.





• - Palm print: use a sponge to apply coloured paint to the palm. Imprint on a white sheet.



## Step 3: Creating charcoal drawings


Estimated time: 30 min


 Now take a charcoal and a sheet and make your own drawing on a "rock" as the cavemen did.
