STEP BY STEP: How to build an ancient Greek mosaic.

Step 1: Prepare the materials for work

Estimated time: 3 min

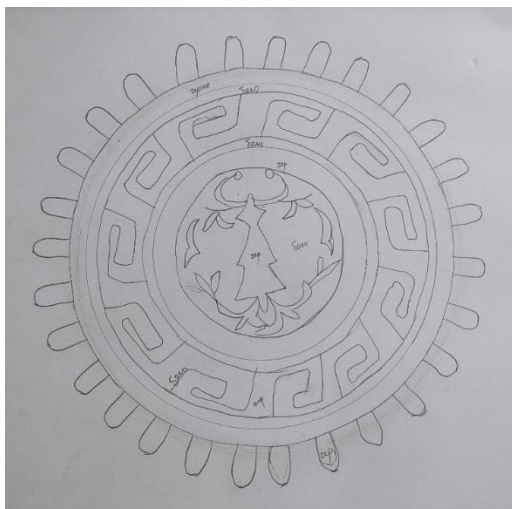


The main material you will need are beans - beans, lentils, sunflower seeds, corn. For the proposed mosaic you will need white beans and sunflower seeds.

Step 2: Draw the mosaic scheme

Estimated time: 30 min

Observe the attached image of a Greek mosaic and carefully redraw it on a piece of cardboard.

Step 3: Stick the beans with glue on the mosaic scheme

Estimated time: 40 min

Tips:

Keep the symmetry and the corresponding colours looking from the pattern.

If desired, brush a clear varnish over the finished mosaic to make it stronger.
