### STEP BY STEP: How to build your own juggling balls

Collect all the necessary materials

#### Step 1:Material preparation



Step 2: Measuring

Estimated time:5 min

Estimated time: 5 min

- Measure 90-100 g of loose material in the scale
- Pour the material into the sandwich bag



#### Step 3:Making ball

Estimated time: 5 min

- Twist the sandwich bag closed making sure you have expelled all the air
- Pull the remaining bag over the first knot and wrap the ball again
- Repeat until the wole length of the bag is used and you have a thight neat bag
- Stick the last part of the sandwich bag with tape










#### Step 4:Decoration

Estimated time: 5 min

- Cut the neck off your ballon and wrap the ballon round the bag
- Cut a second ballon same as the first and wrap the ballon round the covered bag, hole side first



Step 5:Repeat

Estimated time:30 min

• Repeat this procedure for another two balls to make 3 juggling balls



Step 6: Juggling

Estimated time:10 min
